Attendance and entry into competitions will be subject to available space and a waiting list will be kept once capacity is reached.

Both competitions will be played in a "Round Robin" style. The youth competition will feature 4 rounds of games and the adult 8 rounds. Prizes will be awarded to the winning teams accordingly and refreshments served.
